Policy on Student Participation in Political Activities

Purpose

To ensure a peaceful, focused academic environment and maintain institutional neutrality by preventing political interference or disruption within the college premises.

Scope

This policy applies to all enrolled students of MBBS and BDS programs, both on-campus and during official college-related events off-campus.

Policy Statement

- Students are strictly prohibited from engaging in or organizing any political activity, campaign, protest, or demonstration within the college.
- Forming or affiliating with political parties, student unions, or pressure groups is not allowed under any circumstances.
- The use of college resources (facilities, social media, or print) for political messaging or endorsements is forbidden.

Violations and Disciplinary Action

Any breach of this policy may result in:

- Written warning
- Suspension from classes or college
- Expulsion in case of repeated or serious violations

All disciplinary actions will be taken in accordance with the college's Disciplinary Rules and reported to UHS if required.

Appeals

Students may appeal any disciplinary action under this policy by submitting a written request to the Principal within 7 working days.
